

Webelos Woods 2009

Webelos Woods is an overnight camping adventure designed to introduce next years webelos I and II scouts (current bear and webelos 1) and their parents to scouting adventures ahead and to help create excitement for the future transition into Boy Scouts. The weekend is filled with tons of fun activities, demonstrations and plenty of outdoor excitement. **EACH PACK NEEDS TO PREPARE A SKIT OR SONG FOR THE SATURDAY CAMP FIRE.**

Scouts, their leaders and parents need to signup as a pack. Two-deep leadership is required and Guide to Safe Scouting states that scouts are to be supervised by his parent or guardian. Each pack needs at least one Youth Protection Certified Leader on site at all times.

The cost of the event is \$12.00 for each boy and adult in attendance. This includes a Webelos Woods patch, program supplies, insurance, Saturday Dinner, and Sunday Breakfast. Packs must provide their own tents, personal gear, Saturday lunch (Sack lunch from home is a possibility), and Cracker Barrel food. Water will be available on the site. You need a water container. No Ground Fires.

Every participant (boy and adult) needs to turn in a BSA Annual Health and Medical Record Form with parts "A" and "C" filled in.

Webelos Woods check-in/set-up will be on 5/2 at 9am. Opening ceremony at 12pm and activities begin at 12:30pm. Webelos Woods will conclude at 10am Sunday morning 5/3. Registration form will be on the district website (www.rthscouting.org), health forms and money to be turned in at the April Roundtable.
