## Rules and Registration Form

- Check-in begins at 8:00, announcements at 8:25, start time is 8:30, and end time is 11:00. Participants will receive a raffle ticket and registration number to report whenever they catch a fish.
- Each scout will turn in their # between 11:00-11:05. Awards, raffles, special recognition begins at 11:15.
- Only REGISTERED Pack 3250 Scouts and Girl Scouts are eligible for prizes, but siblings can fish too.
- **All scouts must be accompanied by an adult** (18 years of age or older).
- Courtesy spacing: Respect your neighboring anglers; do not fish within 15 feet of others.
- Only fish caught by the scouts can be measured/weighed.
- No foul-hooking of fish (must be caught in a natural fashion in the mouth).
- Scouts should only use 1 pole at a time (no more than 2 at a time allowed please).
- All fish caught by scouts must be measured by an Olathe Bass Club volunteer and recorded.
- Any fish that is 12 inches or longer must be weighed by the tournament director (or representative).
- Handle all fish carefully. They are to be measured/weighed quickly and GENTLY returned into the lake for others to catch and enjoy. Call a volunteer over if you need any help handling a fish properly.
- Live bait (worms) will be provided by the Pack at check-in. We will give out one cup of 5-6 worms each. Remember, you only need a small piece of a worm on your hook, not the whole thing at once. Keep in mind that **you may bring your own worms with you if you'd like or hotdogs, lunchmeat, cheese, etc...** This is strongly recommended so you don't run out of bait.
- Feel free to use artificial baits if you would like to. It is the scout and his/her accompanying adult who is in charge of what you decide to fish with.
- It is the responsibility of each adult for having both a KS fishing license and a Johnson County Parks Permit if they are fishing too. If they are only "assisting", then it is not necessary. Both the license and permit can be purchased at your Olathe Bass Pro Shops (trout stamps are optional). Kids don't need one.
- Prizes will be given out for the longest fish per species and the heaviest fish caught. Bass, bluegill, catfish, crappie, trout and more are all great possibilities at this awesome little lake.
- All scouts who register and participate can **order a commemorative t-shirt for only \$5 (optional)**. *Cash or a check made out to "Pack 3250" is due upon registration (if ordering a t-shirt).*
